Whew! The last 4 weeks have gone fast. The 2014 boating season is here. If you didn't attend one of our 3 seminars (Anchoring, VHF Radio, and Emergencies Afloat) you missed out on improving your safe boating skills in a relaxed, friendly format with Norwalk YC members and DSPS members.

Flare Up was held on Saturday May 3 at Weed Beach. Three (3) stations were set up. The Darien Fire Marshall demonstrated fire extinguisher use. DSPS supervised people shooting expired flares from the shoreline. Darien EMS-Post 53 taught "Hands for Life" (CPR chest compressions).

Frank Kemp was the key to the success with close to 150 participants.

Our Spring Refresher came off without a hitch. The weather cooperated last Saturday morning after the heavy rains rain on Friday night. This was our 3<sup>rd</sup> annual event and each time we have had perfect weather. Thank you to Ted Edwards, Hugh Balloch, Fred Elliott, Gerry Wedell and Sandy & Tom Norelli for being excellent boat captains. This is one of my favorite events to start the season.

Our last event of May is only a few days away. DSPS members and their families will walk in the Darien Memorial Day parade. As in many prior years, the Rowayton Bait shop will trailer a new Mako and pull our "boat float" down the Post Road. The "boat float" will be decorated with flags, banners and streamers. If your son or daughter would like to ride in the boat and wave to their friends in town, see the next page for details. DSPS will provide free entrance passes (\$5 value) to the Post 53 Food Fair at Tilley Pond will be given to the first 25 adults or children that participate.

We will have a tent set up at the Food Fair immediately following the parade. Come visit our tent where we will be promoting safety on the water and hopefully be sailing a few remote controlled sailboats on the pond.
