November 2nd, Presentation/Author - Michael Tougias, author of *Rescue of the Bounty*, will give a dramatic visual presentation about this event at the <u>Norwalk Yacht Club</u>,10 Nathan Hale Dr, Norwalk on November 2nd at 4:30 pm. The tall ship Bounty, featured in the Marlon Brando movie Mutiny on the Bounty, sank during Superstorm Sandy in 2012. The captain and a crewmember perished in the accident but the Coast Guard performed harrowing helicopter rescues to save the other fourteen sailors. Tougias will use slides of the storm, the survivors, and the rescue to make this "an edge-of-your seat" visual program.
