DSPS Member Invitation



Brilliant Beacons is a work rich in maritime lore and brimming with original historic detail. In his book Mr. Dolin presents the most comprehensive history of American lighthouses ever written. The book traces the evolution of America's lighthouse system, highlighting the political, military, and technological battles to establish the system we have today. In his talk, Mr. Dolin will tell stories of many interesting events and colorful characters involved in the development and operation of our lighthouses.



Eric has advance degrees in environmental management and has worked for the National Fisheries Service, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Harvard's Museum of Comparative Zoology as well as many domestic and foreign environment agencies.
